- **Your artwork MUST be priced \$200 or under.**
- We will provide tags for you to fill out to attach to your work.
- At this time you will hang your own artwork USING OUR NAILS, which we will provide. We will have a limited supply of hammers so you may want to bring your own.
- A lot of artists participate in this event so please be considerate when hanging your artwork!

### **Chili, Cheap & Chilly: Saturday, December 9, from 10 am – 4 pm**

**Artists are asked to bring items from the list below:**

- Pot of chili, DELIVERED HOT!
- Italian/French bread or rolls
- Shredded cheese
- Cider
- Sour Cream
- Plastic bags (in case it's raining and people can use them to wrap up purchased artwork)

### **Pick-up: Saturday, December 9, from 4-5 pm**

- Unsold work must be picked up between the hours of 4 - 5 pm on the same day as Chili, Cheap & Chilly. NO EXCEPTIONS!

There is limited heat in the building so come warmly dressed and ready to have a good time!

No Entry Fee for Chili, Cheap & Chilly, but artists are asked to bring specific food items on the day of the Exhibition.

**Media:** We accept artwork in any medium, including computer-generated and photography. No direct copies, giclees, crafts, commercially produced works or usage of other artists' works will be accepted.

**ALL WORK** needs to be clearly labeled on the back with the artist's name and address and title of artwork.

**Framing & Display:** All artwork must be ready to hang and not weigh more than 25 pounds. Work that is matted and wrapped is acceptable for this exhibit only.

**No "wet" paintings will be accepted.**

**For Chili, Cheap and Chilly Exhibit only:** artists will be hanging their own work on Wednesday December 6 and may replace sold works during the exhibit on Saturday December 9, with other artwork.

**Size:** Space is usually very limited so smaller works are recommended for this exhibit. Please be considerate of your neighbors.

**Sales & Commissions:** All works must be for sale and priced \$200 or under. The EAA will receive 25% from all sales. Payments to artists will be disbursed when final payment has been received from the buyer. Selling artists may claim EAA commissions as tax-deductible donations to the extent allowable by law.

**Liability Statement:** The EAA, Inc. does not maintain insurance covering, and will not assume any responsibility or liability relating to, loss of or damage to works of art while in the possession of the EAA, Inc. By submitting works of art, each exhibitor acknowledges they have been so advised, and relieves the EAA, Inc., its officers, director, and members from any liability with respect thereto. Art may be excluded if deemed inappropriate by the Council.
